Proposal

Village Gateway on B5032 from Uttoxeter before Middle Mayfield. Replace the "Please Slow Down" sign with a Mayfield Heritage Sign including the words "Gateway to the Peaks" using the existing support frame with a planter.

Village Gateway at Upper Mayfield at Junction of A52 with Hollow Lane – A Mayfield Heritage Sign including the words "Gateway to the Peaks" mounted on a planter.

Village Gateway at the Junction of B5032 and A52 near the Openreach cabinets - A Mayfield Heritage Sign including the words "Gateway to the Peaks" mounted on a frame with a planter

Village Gateway at the entrance to The Terrace after the bridge over the Dove at a point to be agreed with the Mill owners. A Mayfield Heritage sign with the words "Please Drive Carefully" mounted on a planter.

Notes -

1. Timescales -

Planning and permits – open ended – dependent on County and Borough Councils – this is a sensitivity as the grant has a deadline by which it must be spent.

Sign and planter manufacture and installation of gateways – indicative 10 weeks from receipt of all permits and approvals and placing of orders.

- 2. Funding Ideally funding in two tranches
 - a) To enable drawing work and application for permits and permissions.
 - b) To enable placing of orders for manufacture and installation of equipment, once permits and licences have been granted.
- 3. It has been assumed the Gateway at the Terrace will be on Mill land and will not require Planning Permission or licences.
- 4. If the orders are placed by the Parish Council, and the asset will be owned by the Parish Council, it may be possible to claim the VAT back on products and services that carry VAT.
- 5. Depending on the final design of the Gateways the County Council have certain powers on the highway which may obviate the need to gain planning permission from the Borough Council. This will need to be established with the County Council at the earliest opportunity once design and positioning of Gateways is finalised.
- 6. The artist of the Mayfield Heritage Design has kindly given permission for it to be used on the Gateways.
